As an intelligence officer, she completed tours in the Middle East and South America, along with multiple temporary duty assignments in warzones. Her most recent assignment is with the Associate Director for Military Affairs (ADMA) focusing on intelligence liaison and instruction in support of the U.S. military.

Ms. Krawczyk holds a Master of Arts degree in National Security Studies from Georgetown University and a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science from the U.S. Naval Academy.
